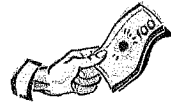

Instead of stressing keeping the law to protect God's holiness as the priests and Pharisees did, Jesus stressed giving thanks for the many gifts we received from God's mercy and the task of sharing them with others.
