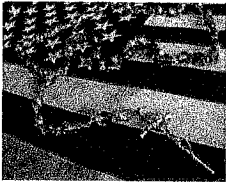

From today's Gospel reading:

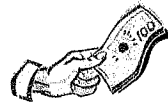
At that time, the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit.

So we ask ourselves:
