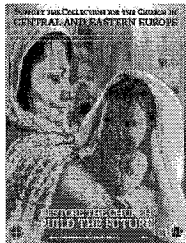

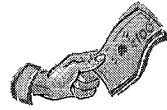

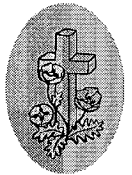

-Chow with the Chaplains: Have lunch with a local pastor every Tuesday and Friday from 11:30 to 1 in Upper Manser.

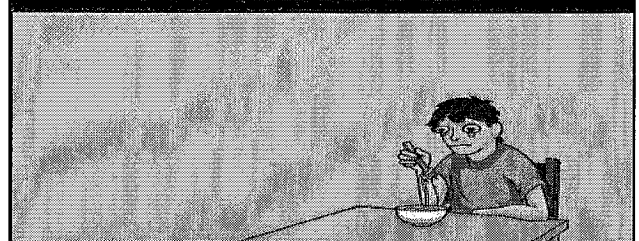


