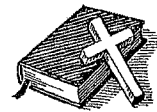
In addition, we received \$938.00 for Hurricane Matthew. This money is sent to the Diocese of Scranton.

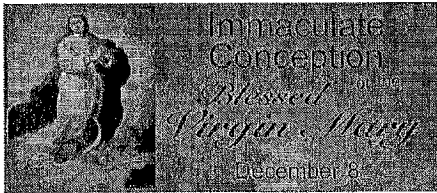

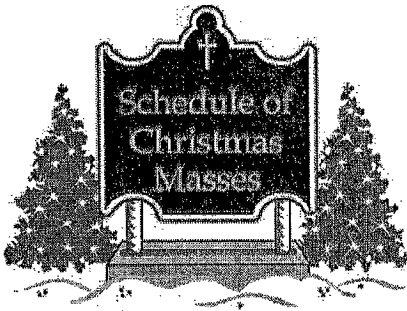

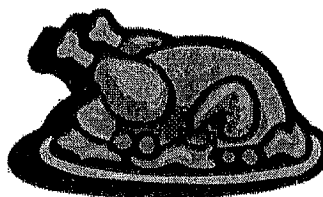

St. Peter's, Wellsboro

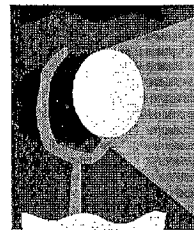
