Mission Statement: Holy Child Parish

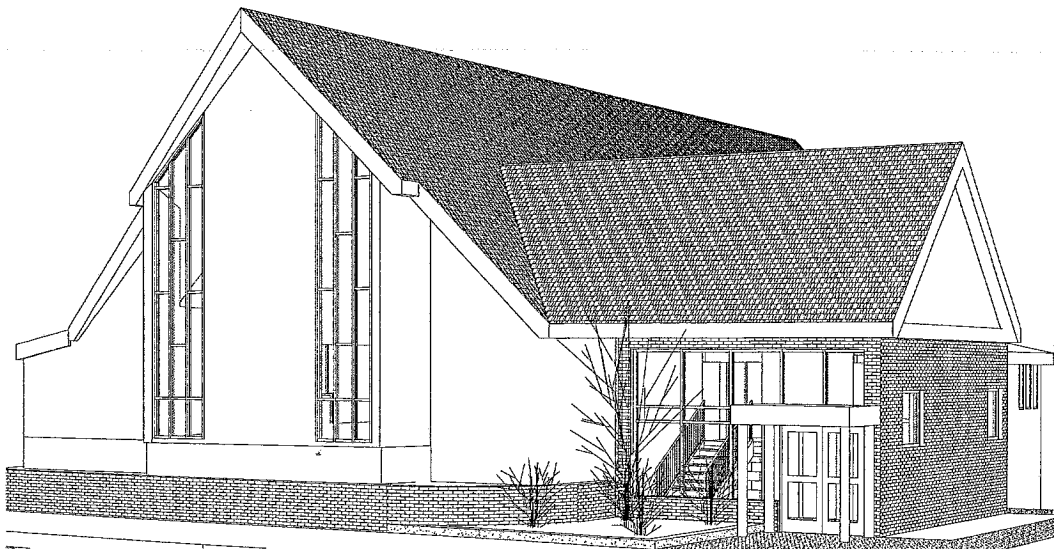

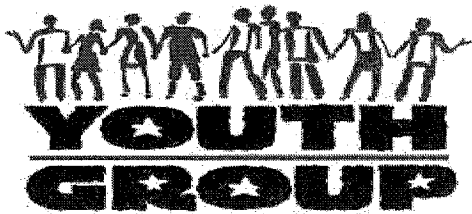

To respect our parishioners' privacy, please ask and specify if their names are to be put in the bulletin or added to the prayer chain or both.

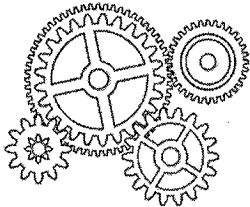

Just a reminder... In honor of the 100th Anniversary of Fatima, Pope Francis has granted a plenary indulgence opportunity throughout the entire anniversary year:

To obtain the indulgence: visit with devotion and pray before any statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory, or proper place on the **13th of each month from May to October 2017**, and there devoutly participate in some celebration or prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary, pray the "Our Father," recite the "Creed," and invoke Our Lady of Fatima.

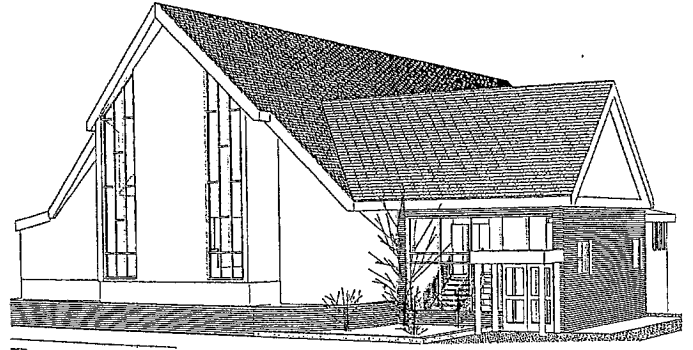
To obtain any plenary indulgence one must also: Go to confession, receive Holy Communion, be interiorly detached from all sin, and Pray the intentions of the Holy Father.

Over the next few months, the Diocese of Scranton will **#PartnerwithFrancis** and gather the voices of the 'young church' (16-35) and those who work with them in our eleven counties.

What are the blessings/challenges for young people today? What do young people need from the church? What do young people want from the church? What can be done to keep young people involved in the faith? Etc.

The answers to all those questions will be compiled in a report and given to Pope Francis in preparation for the 2018 Synod on *Young People, the Faith and Vocational Discernment*. The results will not only help the Pope and Bishop from around the world, but will also shape programming for the young church here in the Diocese of Scranton.

Holy Child Building Project

Bishop Barbara approved Phase One of the Holy Child Parish building project.

Phase One provides handicap accessibility to Holy Child Church. This is achieved in two ways: through an elevator and a handicap accessible ramp.

The elevator will be housed in a structure at the side entrance to the Church near the sacristy. The handicap ramp will be located at the front entrance to the church.

Phase One will also include a handicap accessible restroom in the room currently being used as a confessional.

Finally, Phase One will include protective thermo-pane windows at the front entrance to the church.

The architect is now creating construction documents which will be used for bidding. After the contracts are awarded, construction will begin.

Please continue to pray for the successful completion of Phase One and for the planning and development of Phase Two, which will address the parish center.



Quo Vadis Days 2017

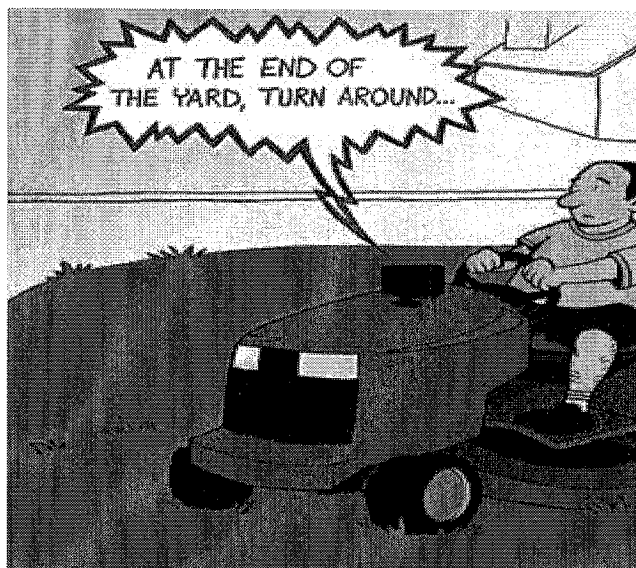
