



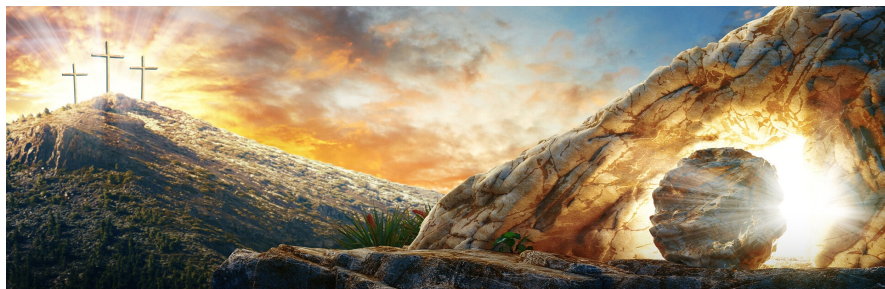

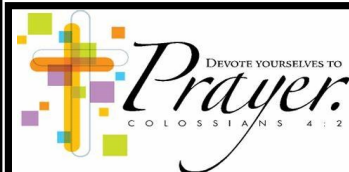

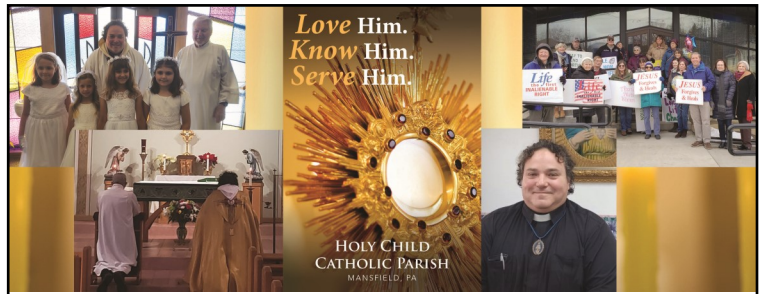
NOTE: Times are approximate. When the Novena follows a Mass, it will start immediately after the Mass.

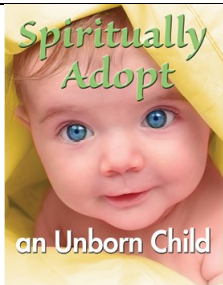

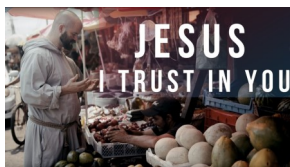

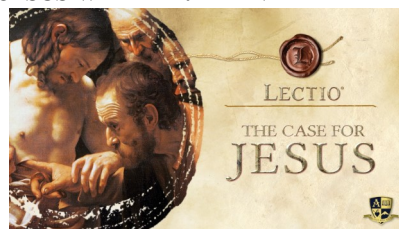
