



PARISH HEALTH MINISTRY

It comes sneaking out, invisible, odorless, tasteless, yet deadly. The symptoms of this invisible killer are often mistaken for cold or flu symptoms: fatigue, headache, shortness of breath, nausea, and dizziness. This myste-

rious invisible killer is carbon monoxide. Prevention and monitoring are the best ways to avoid carbon monoxide. Have your furnace and other appliances professionally installed and serviced regularly. Never run a gas-powered generator indoors, even with the windows open, deadly levels of carbon monoxide will quickly develop. Be sure that dryer vents and gas appliance vents are clear of obstructions and snow. Install carbon monoxide alarms outside every sleeping area in your home. A good rule of thumb is to replace the batteries and check that the alarm is functioning properly twice a year with the change of times in Spring and Fall. Also a good rule for your smoke alarms, too. Have a safe holiday season.




SPIRITUAL ADOPTION OF THE PREBORN—MONTH FOUR
