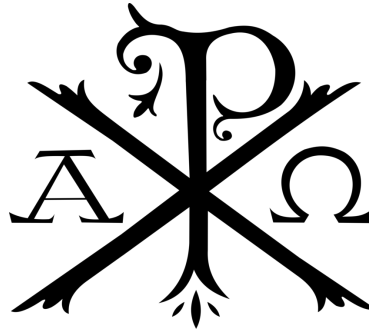

The most basic preventative measure is to warm up. Perform stretches to get muscles ready for activity. 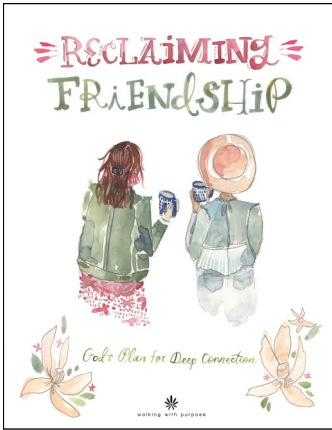

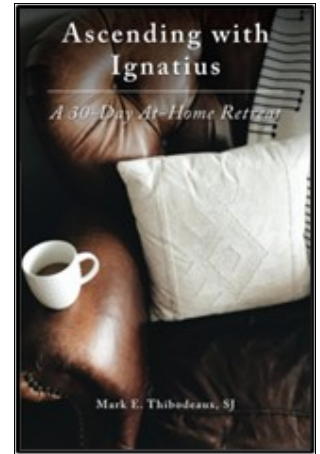
Men's Book Study
