#### HEALTH MINISTRY—NOTES

Support caregivers! Caregiving can be emotionally and physically challenging, especially at this time of year. The stress of providing care to someone, especially a family member,

can take a toll on the caregiver's overall wellbeing. Depression and a sense of isolation and loneliness are often felt by caregivers. Communication is one way to combat feelings of isolation and depression. How to help? Text or call at regular intervals just to check in. Plan get togethers or participate in activities as schedules permit. Discuss topics outside the caregiving role such as interests and hobbies. Offer assistance if even for only a short time. All of these can provide a much needed break and rejuvenation. As you stress about the upcoming holidays, remember the caregivers; nurses, doctors, aides, mothers with babies, family members caring for loved ones, and let them know you are thinking of them, too.
