



HEALTH MINISTRY—NOTES

Happy Thanksgiving! As the weather becomes colder and darkness comes sooner, turning lights on at four o'clock in the afternoon still feels odd, we tend to find food as a comfort for the gloom. Of course, the

holidays don't always help either. The biggest one being Thanksgiving. But one way to avoid the winter layer of insulation that comes from overeating and being less active is to add more fiber to your diet. Roughage, fiber used to be known as this, has been found to reduce cholesterol, cut down on weight gain and feed your gut's microbiome. So how to add more fiber to that wonderful Thanksgiving meal? First off have more vegetable options. Sliced fresh vegetables with a hummus dip, made from ground chickpeas, is a great appetizer to your turkey dinner. Try sweet potatoes, or yams, instead of mashed potatoes as they are loaded with fiber and vitamins. Sneak a little fiber in your pie desert by adding flaxseed to the crust or into your cake batter. Also that pumpkin and apple pie add additional fiber to the dessert. So enjoy the time with your family and friends and remember to sneak in the roughage.
