FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Happy Solemnity of The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph! This celebration occurs on the cusp of a new calendar year. As we begin the New Year, we should keep in mind the sacredness of the family and make a resolve to grow in Faith as a family and to pray for families. In the apparition known as "Our Lady of Good Success," Mary revealed that the last big battle, instigated by the Devil, would be over the family. She asked for prayer for the family.

During this past year we celebrated the 75th anniversary of the first Rosary Rally ever held in the United States, organized by Fr. Patrick Peyton to reignite the untold benefits of devotion to the Rosary and prayer to Our Blessed Mother. His slogan was "the family that prays together stays together." Perhaps as we begin this New Year we can make a resolve to pray the Rosary together as a family? The family Rosary is powerful and yields many fruits.

As we begin this New Year, it would be beneficial to make the nine (9) *First Friday* or five (5) *First Saturday* devotions. Both of these devotions are from Heaven. They make significant promises that should not be easily dismissed. They are special blessings, fountains of Grace. How "Grace-filled" it would be to make these devotions as a family!

12 Promises of the Sacred Heat to St. Margaret Mary (First Friday Devotion)

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- 2. I will give peace in their families.
- 3. I will console them in all their troubles.
- 4. I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
- 5. I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
- 6. Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
- 9. I will bless those places wherein image of my Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
- 10. I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.
- 12. In the excess of the mercy of my heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grae of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

Lent will be here before we know it! It would be good to attend the Stations of the Cross as a family.
