## HEALTH MINISTRY—NOTES

Baby it's cold outside! As the temperature dips and the wind whistles around we are all staying indoors more. Along with staying indoors comes possible exposure to indoor allergens, as well as cold and flu viruses. Some ways to decrease those allergens and germs is to use an indoor air cleaning system. One that is certified to eliminate allergens and germs. Sweeping your furniture and window treatments at least twice a week is another way to cut down on the allergens. Protecting your mattress and pillows with allergen resistant covers will help control dust mites Leaving pets out of the bedroom will control pet dander. Remember that humidity will cut down on floating allergens and germs too. Keep your home humidity levels between 35 to 50 percent. This level prevents the static shocks that occur in a dry environment and keeps allergens from floating around when someone moves through the house. Stay healthy in spite of the weather.

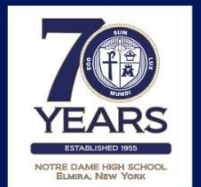
