

Dr. Brant Pitre goes back to the Bible and ancient tradition, shedding light on the little-known Jewish roots of Christmas. You will learn about:



#### HEALTH MINISTRY—NOTES

To supplement or not to supplement? That is the question. The answer is generally "no." Taking a multivitamin supplement every day really does nothing that a well balanced diet won't help. When visiting your primary care provider a few

questions you may want to consider should include; do I need a vitamin D supplement? Am I anemic? Do I need my B12 and Iron measured / supplemented? Unfortunately, as we age, we do not always absorb all the nutrients that a well balanced diet contains. Simple blood tests may indicate a certain vitamin deficiency and a specific supplement for that may be prescribed. Fat-soluble vitamins such as A, K, E, and D are toxic to your system when taken in excessive amounts. Vitamin E in high amounts causes bleeding problems, that is why your surgeon needs to know your complete medication list. Being fat-soluble it may take three to four weeks for your body to eliminate the excess thereby decreasing your surgical risk. Bottom line is that in most cases a balanced diet is all you need to provide your body with all its necessary nutrients.

#### Policies and Procedures Effective January 2025

#### **Registration Fees**

Payment must accompany registrations for an event. Cash, or checks payable to "St. Peter's Church," can be dropped into the collection baskets at St. Peter's or Holy Child or mailed to St. Peter's Church, 47 Central Avenue, Wellsboro, PA 16901. Scholarships are available for those who experience hardships.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

To receive reimbursement, cancellations must be made two weeks before an event. This includes retreats, brunches, pilgrimages, and other events. No refunds will be made after this deadline. Waiting lists are created when an event is full and spaces will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Caterer and other fees are paid in advance, so funds are lost when participants cancel or don't attend. These policies will also help us accommodate people on waiting lists. Thank you for your understanding as we look forward to another year of providing holy experiences for our parishes.
