


#### Food Pantry

### FASTING AND ABSTINENCE:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence...

- Fasting: Obligatory for Roman Catholics from ages 18-59 years. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
- Abstinence: Abstaining from eating meat is obligatory for Roman Catholics ages 14 years and older. Obligatory on Fridays in Lent.


