HEALTH MINISTRY NOTES

April showers bring May flowers. So what do May showers bring? Mosquitoes! Mosquitoes carry many diseases and skin infections. Are you aware that only the female bites? The best way to decrease your chance of getting sick from a mosquito bite is to prevent it in

the first place. Using a mosquito repellent spray each time you go out, even if it only sitting on the front porch watching the sunset, will help keep those pesky flying insects away. Another preventative measure you can do is remove their habitats. Empty all containers with standing water in them, even the bird bath needs emptied and cleaned out on a regular basis. Mosquito larvae hatch in standing water. Anything that holds water is the perfect breeding spot for that annoying little creature. Nature provides effective control measures such as barn swallows and bats. But they will definitely need help this wet and soggy spring. So enjoy the nice weather, whenever it may happen, but remember to protect yourself from that pesky disease carrying insect.
