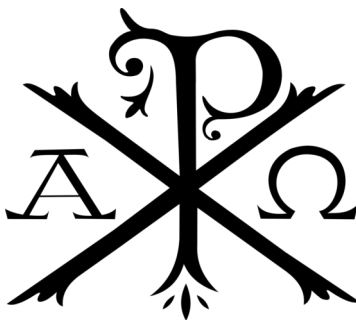

## HOLY CHILD HEALTH MINISTRY

*New members needed; all are welcome!*



As the flu and respiratory season is in full swing across our communities here are a few reminders for you.

**For flu-like symptoms** (such as fever, cough, sore throat, body aches or congestion)... **don't go to the emergency room.** This only leads to longer waiting times and crowded conditions in the ER causing a reduction of services for those truly critical patients.

So what do you do? **Start with your primary care provider or make use of the walk-in clinics** available at most physician offices for symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, fever (greater than 100.4) or a runny nose.

**For more severe symptoms** (such as difficulty breathing, severe dehydration, dizziness or confusion, persistent vomiting, or chest pain)... **use the emergency room.**

To help prevent the spread of all respiratory illnesses:

- **Wash your hands** with warm, soapy water for at least 20 seconds **when you return home / before eating / before touching your face**; this is the most important thing you can do. Use lotion if your skin becomes dry.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes.
- Stay home from work or school when you're sick.
- Get plenty of rest and drink plenty of fluids to prevent clogged respiratory passages (sinuses, nose, and lungs).

*Only you can help prevent colds and flu this season!*

### REPORTING ABUSE OF A MINOR

It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. Per the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour “Childline” Child Abuse hotline 1-800-932-0313 or [compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://compass.state.pa.us/cwis). The Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.
