






## SOUP-ER BOWL!



### FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

- \* **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence (from eating meat).
- \* **Fridays during Lent** are obligatory days of abstinence (from eating meat).
- \* Abstinence from eating meat is obligatory for all Roman Catholics beginning at age 14 years.
- \* Fasting is obligatory for all Roman Catholics ages 18-59 years; a person is permitted to eat one full meal, and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.







## HOLY CHILD HEALTH MINISTRY

New members needed; all are welcome!

As the flu and respiratory season is in full swing across our communities here are a few reminders for you.



**For flu-like symptoms** (such as fever, cough, sore throat, body aches or congestion)... **don't go to the emergency room.** This only leads to longer waiting times and crowded conditions in the ER causing a reduction of services for those truly critical patients.

So what do you do? **Start with your primary care provider or make use of the walk-in clinics** available at most physician offices for symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, fever (greater than 100.4) or a runny nose.

**For more severe symptoms** (such as difficulty breathing, severe dehydration, dizziness or confusion, persistent vomiting, or chest pain)... **use the emergency room.**

To help prevent the spread of all respiratory illnesses:

- **Wash your hands** with warm, soapy water for at least 20 seconds **when you return home / before eating / before touching your face;** this is the most important thing you can do. Use lotion if your skin becomes dry.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes.
- Stay home from work or school when you're sick.
- Get plenty of rest and drink plenty of fluids to prevent clogged respiratory passages (sinuses, nose, and lungs).

*Only you can help prevent colds and flu this season!*
